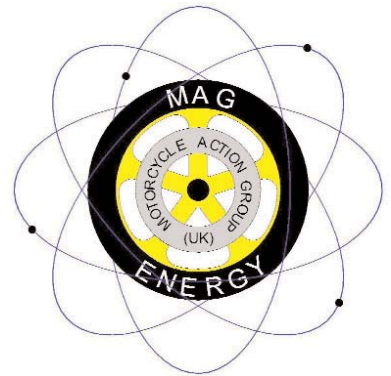

JEB'S DNA JET OPEN FACED HELMET by Mollie O'Connell - Age 9 ? -

My dad bought a selection of bike helmets in a closing down sale and they've been quite well worn over the years so it was a nice surprise when he turned up with a new one for me. The old helmets were ugly and not well padded, and they hurt when I wore them for any time.

This one looks good with a matt black finish with silver and grey stripes, and the visor has a blue tint which I like when it's sunny, but it's only for daytime use if you're riding. There's a clear visor option though.

The shell is bigger than the old ones but that's to fit in loads of thick squidgy padding so it's really comfortable. The chin strap includes a soft plastic part which moulds round you and is nice to chew! It pulls in the padding which makes it fit better around my ears which helps to keep them covered from the wind and keep the noise out (like my dad waffling and singing). The helmet shell is flexible and the strap does up like a seat belt so it's easy to get on and off and isn't as fiddly to adjust as the older ones. It only weighs 1000g so it doesn't hurt my neck



and it's light to carry around, like when I go shopping with my dad, or out for an ice-cream with my mum. I've worn it for a while now and it's so much better than those old ones. If I had to mark it out of 10, it would get 10 for weight, 9 for comfort, 9 for looks, 10 for taking on and off, and 10 for noise (or should that be quiet?). Thanks for the helmet Mutch!

A helmet that cuts out the waffling and singing of our Vice Chairman and has a strap that is good to chew - Bonus!
