Racing was held once a fortnight on Thursdays and the main MHB Services League was won by Dusty Devils, while the Novice



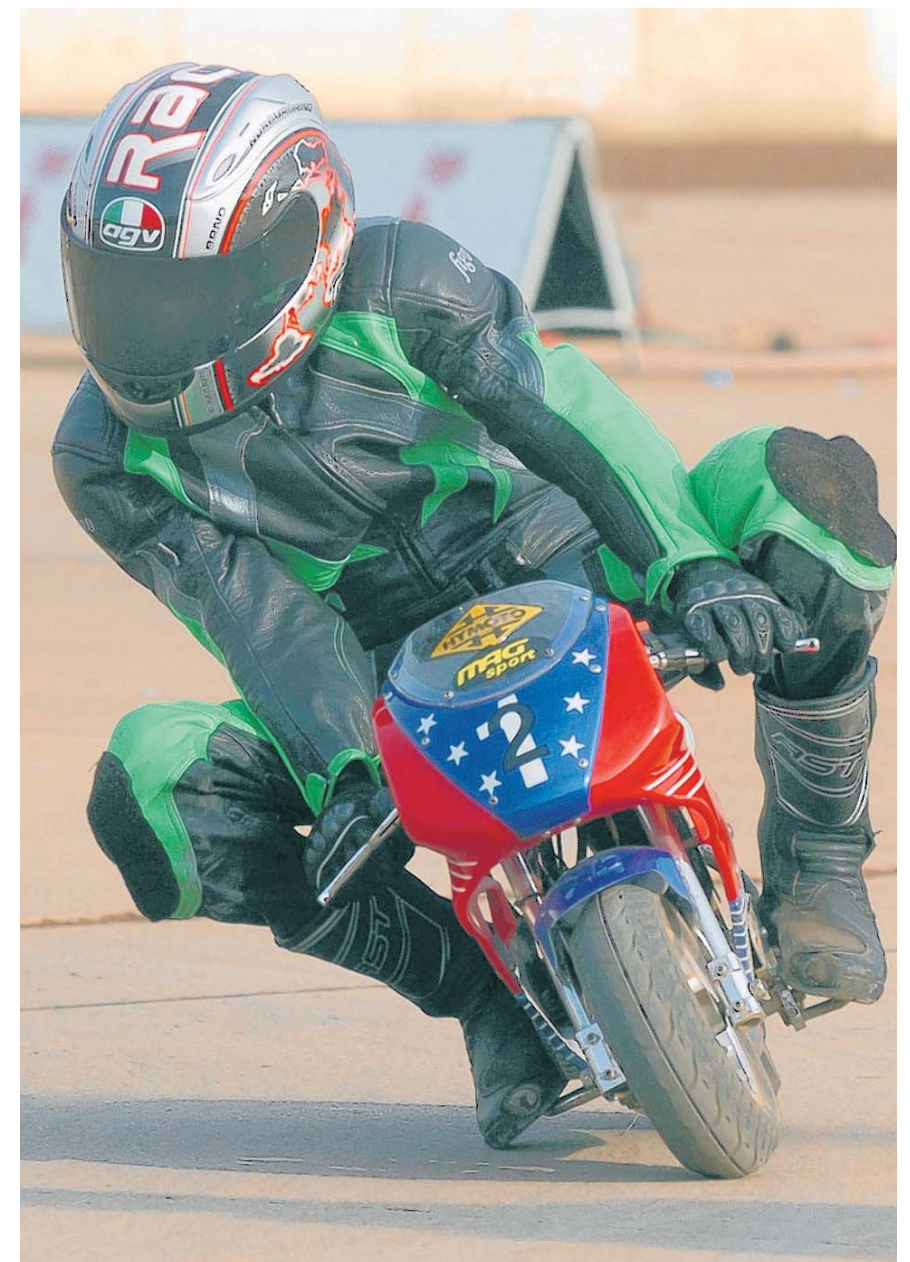
Tussling for position: Close action from the final meeting of the Moto KL season at the Norfolk Arena Picture by Alan Miller, 08AM10481
